- Put your garbage out at the nearest waste station by the morning of the collection day.
- Burnable and non-burnable waste should be put in the designated waste bags and the free-of-charge waste should be put in ordinary transparent bags.

## Waste not collected by the Town

### ●Prohibited items

Items such as TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, tumble dryers, air conditioners, PCs, tires, batteries, fire extinguishers. Please arrange for them to be dealt with by vendors or specialist contractors.

### ●Large amounts of waste (when moving, etc.)

If you have to dispose of large amounts of waste, for example when moving to a new house, please make your own arrangements for transportation to a waste disposal site, or contact a professional waste disposal company.
